Dear Clubs

As preparations continue for the 2025 season, registrations have opened today via Squadi for advanced competitions including NPL, FQPL 1–6 and FQ Academy Leagues.

Registrations for community competitions across the state will open this Friday, 25 October.

As confirmed in FQ Memo 21-24, governing body fees for MiniRoos, Juniors and Seniors will remain unchanged for the 2025 season, leaving Queensland with Australia's lowest registration fees.

Local venue fees have also been confirmed as clubs are reminded that the cost of managing football facilities is heavily influenced by local factors and is separate to the governance and administration of football.

Football Australia's National Registration Fee is yet to be confirmed for 2025.

A club's participation in any league for the 2025 season is contingent upon final league design, affiliation confirmation, approval and compliance of a variety of conditions (mandatory of others) contained within various participation licence agreements. No participation is guaranteed to any club in any league until the Final Declaration of Leagues is made by Football Queensland.
